Fiber Arts features a compilation of all fiber arts other than quilting and sewing—embroidery, crewel, needle point, rug hooking, punch needle work, knitting of all kinds, crocheting, weaving of all types-on loom and off loom, basketry, spinning (all fibers), and weaving, knitting and crocheting using handspun.

General Rules for Fiber Arts:

1. LIMIT Two Entries Per Class per Exhibitor.
2. Exhibits entered must be the work of the Exhibitor.
3. Exhibits previously entered are not eligible.
4. Exhibits of clothing need to be on a hanger for display.
5. Pictures must be properly framed and ready to hang.
6. Items must be clean and pressed.
7. All framed items entered under a lot number with a designated size will be measured by stitched area that will not include the frame.

Hints to Exhibitors:

Exhibits are judged on the following basis:
Cleanliness, neatness, and finishing-----10%
Amount of work required to complete-----40%
Degree of perfection of completed exhibit-50%

HANDSTITCHED

Class Numbers

- 800 Counted Cross Stitch item, table cloth, pillow, wall hanging.
- 801 Counted Cross Stitch picture, less than 12"
- 802 Counted Cross Stitch picture, over 12".
- 803 Crewel less than 12"
- 804 Crewel over 12"
- 805 Needle Point – Picture
- 806 Plastic Canvas - 3-D
- 807 Plastic Canvas – flat object
- 808 Embroidered Dish towels
- 809 Embroidered pillow cases or dresser scarf, pillow
- 810 Hand stitched miscellaneous

CROCHET

Class Numbers

- 811 Crochet afghan, commercial yarn
- 812 Crochet baby items

KNITTING

Class Numbers

- 822** Knitted adult sweater, commercial yarn

- 826** Knitted beading work – any item
- 827** Knitted child's sweater, commercial yarn
- 828** Knitted mittens, slippers, socks, hats, leg warmers, purses, scarves; accessories, commercial yarn.
- 829** Knitted dolls, toys or garments, commercial yarn

HANDWOVEN/HANDSPUN

Class Numbers

- 844** Felted item, handspun yarn
- 845** Hand dyed wool yarn, 25 yards, chemical dye
- 846** Hand dyed wool yarn, 25 yards, natural dye
